The Service Learning Requirement (SLR) will confirm your initial application of principles you learned from the content of this course to people in your life or ministry. **It must be** (1) a planned, intentional activity conducted during this course enrollment period, (2) course content-related and (3) be two to three paragraphs in length. **The SLR** may be completed in a church or non-church setting. Should reflect on the content of the course as you consider how the subject matter under investigation relates to your own theology of ministry and your ministry goals and objectives. Evaluate the process of critical analysis and the cognitive ordering of information and materials into thoughtful and potentially useful patterns and structures. Apply acquired knowledge and skills in a personally integrated, effective and cohesive fashion. Should consist of any valid and meaningful ministry experience that incorporates this specific course's content and interacts with other people. Will be assessed by your mentor as satisfactory or unsatisfactory. Credit and a grade for the course will be granted only after the SLR report is submitted and assessed as satisfactorily completed.
