- Studying in a group provides immediate contextual application of concepts including discussion, group motivation, accountability, shared knowledge, and affirmation.
- A study group provides helpful study resources and testing instruments for content mastery.

Section One: Getting Started

We are excited you have chosen to study with Global University's *School for Evangelism and Discipleship*. These easy-to-follow steps will enable you to begin and facilitate your study group. There are options presented in each step that provide different benefits for your study group. **Please review this manual thoroughly before filling out any forms or ordering materials**. Section One will get you started, Section Two provides information on launching, and Section Three lays a foundation for the ongoing instruction and facilitating of the study group.

There should be a meeting or series of meetings to go through these stages:

1. Planning

- Pray about the study group.
- Survey a potential pool of people.
- Form a leadership team.
- Identify a location.
- Determine the order in which courses will be studied and develop a calendar.

2. Recruiting Staff

- Appoint a coordinator and record keeper.
- Enlist facilitators. Facilitators are responsible for interactive activities including reviewing course content, leading discussions, guiding course progress, utilizing presentation tools, and other group activities that promote student learning and growth.
 - ♦ Facilitators are NOT required to possess advanced degrees in theology because the curriculum is designed to be self-taught. However, individuals with subject knowledge and/or educational and classroom experience may serve as excellent facilitators.
 - ♦ The principal role of the facilitator is to encourage and guide interaction among the adult learners and to assist in clarifying any issues that arise.

3. Promoting

- While you have a great deal of flexibility in naming and promoting your study group, you may not claim
 accreditation for your local group, nor may you refer to yourself as an extension of Global University
 or the School for Evangelism and Discipleship. These are issues relating to our accrediting associations
 and are strictly forbidden.
- Consider creative approaches to advertising and promoting the study group in your church or community, such as a special kick-off or commissioning meeting. Global University provides some promotional tools such as brochures, posters, and other advertising e-files with graphics upon request. 4. Meeting

• Meet with all potential students to fill out forms, share about the first course, and receive fee payments.

Section Two: Launching a Study Group

There are two main options in how to launch a study group: 1) FULL-SERVICE ENROLLMENT, and 2) SELF-SERVICE ENROLLMENT. Please review each step and determine which option will best meet your needs.

STEP 1

• Fill out **Form A, "Study Group Agreement"** in this manual. All study groups must have this form on file with Global University. Do this during the initial planning stage. The "Study Group Agreement" form is also available as a fillable PDF at http://www.globaluniversity.edu/PDF/Global University Agreement Form.pdf.

STEP 2

- Fill out **Form B, "Student Application"** for each student. Each student MUST sign their application Form B. Under the restrictions of federal law (FERPA), without the student's signature, Global University is unable to release academic information to the study group leadership. Do this during the meeting stage.
- Students who have already submitted Form B and are enrolling in subsequent courses do not need to submit a new Form B unless the student's information has changed.
- SELF-SERVICE ENROLLMENT OPTION: The \$15 application fee per student is waived by going to http://sed.globalutraining.com and entering each student's application information individually. Please note that **Form B must still be submitted** to Global University for academic information to be released to the study group.

STEP 3

- Complete Form C, "Student Enrollment Form".
- FULL-SERVICE ENROLLMENT: The Student Enrollment Form also provides an option to purchase the printed textbook. Enrolled students will have access to the full text online, as well as the self-assessment questions and final exam. Purchasing the textbook is for those who desire a print copy for their personal use. The study group information is required on the form, as well as each student's name, the course they are enrolling in, and whether a printed textbook is to be ordered. Beginning students will be given a username and password by Student Services.
- SELF-SERVICE ENROLLMENT: Enrollment in the first and subsequent courses may be done locally at http://sed.globalutraining.com. Each student must be enrolled separately using a valid credit card. At this time MULTIPLE ENROLLMENTS USING THE SAME CARD ARE NOT POSSIBLE.

ADDITIONAL ORDERING & PAYMENT INFORMATION:

- Course costs and fees as well as pertinent information relating to shipping is found on Form D, "Discipleship Study Group Course Cost and Fees".
- Orders submitted by mail or fax will need to be completed using **Form E**, "**SED Order Form**" (the individual student information on Form E is not necessary when ordering for multiple students using Form C). The chosen method of payment should be checked and credit card information clearly printed or check enclosed for the full amount including textbooks and fees.
- Place orders at least two weeks before a group study begins.
- Orders may be placed only by the individuals listed on your Global University Agreement Form. To authorize additional people to place orders, notify Global University in writing.
- Normal fulfillment time is 2–3 days; time may vary due to seasonal postage traffic.

- Payment information:
 - ♦ The first order must be paid in advance or with a credit card.
 - ♦ An account may be billed for subsequent orders.
 - ♦ All invoices must be paid within 30 days of the invoice date.
 - ♦ Any account **not** paid within 30 days will require advance payment for subsequent orders. Billing privileges may be restored after 6 months by filling out a credit application.
- Return of materials and cancellation of enrollment:
 - ♦ Return of materials and withdrawal of students: See Form D for Global University's cancellation, withdrawal, and refund policy.
- No application or enrollment fees are mailed in for SELF-ENROLLMENT. However, Forms A and B are still required.
- Payment is required for textbook orders along with Form E for study groups who facilitated with SELF-SERVICE ENROLLMENT.

Section Three: Instruction and Facilitation

Group Instruction

- The purpose of reviewing the course content in a class session is to reinforce, rehearse, amplify, and promote application of the material taught in the course.
- There is no required approach to conducting group learning related to the Discipleship courses. There is a suggested sequence to go through the courses, but each study group may determine their own sequence and calendar.
- Classroom activities should include motivational dynamics that encourage students to master subject matter beyond that which independent study would produce.
- Accountability for progress and completion is a unique benefit of group study and should be emphasized through classroom dynamics.
- Focus on student affirmation should be maintained in all classroom activities.

Instructor's Guides

- New and improved Instructor's Guides are under revision. Approved study groups will be given access to the outdated Instructor Guides online upon request at no additional cost. The Instructor Guides will provide scope and sequence for the facilitator and may be printed as desired.
- The enhanced Instructor's Guides will be made available in the future.

Administration

- Global University maintains student subject lists and financial records for all officially enrolled students. This includes those who enrolled through full-service and self-service enrollment online.
- The following records should be maintained locally as the minimum for quality administration:
 - ♦ Enrollment information, including student names, usernames and passwords, course names and numbers, enrollment dates, and withdrawal dates (if applicable).
 - ♦ Student attendance.
 - ♦ Student grades for unit exams.
 - ♦ Correspondence with Global University related to payments and documentation.

Examinations

- On-line Exams. Final exams are available to be taken online utilizing a password system for students that officially enroll with SED. It is recommended that students take advantage of this system. It provides immediate feedback and gives the student his or her exam score.
- Printed Exams. If printed exams are preferred, request paper copies of the exam and answer sheets from our Student Services office. Exams for the entire study group should be returned to Student Services in one envelope. Exams should be grouped according to course. The following items should be returned when the course is complete.
 - ♦ The exam and answer sheet.
 - ♦ The closed-book exam validation certificate (exam cover sheet).
 - ♦ Be sure students fill out the answer sheet completely when they take the exams. Include student's name, student login, course number, and exam form in the appropriate location.

Completing Courses and Programs

- Upon completion of a course and online final exam the students will receive a final grade immediately. Study groups that mail in answer sheets will receive final grades by email.
- Students who successfully complete the course work and final exam for all of the courses in a series will be
 awarded a certificate for Christian Life and a diploma for Christian Service. The Study Group Coordinator may
 contact the Registrar's office at Global University and request certificates and diplomas for their study group.
 NOTE: They must be listed as a designated person for the study group with permission to receive personal
 information for the students.
- Students are strongly encouraged to pursue lifetime learning. The School for Evangelism and Discipleship courses are eligible for transfer, under certain restrictions, into an undergraduate program with Global University. For any questions concerning potential transfer of credit please contact SED@globaluniversity.edu.

Unofficial Option: Personal Enrichment Studies Only

In some instances official enrollment will not be applicable, therefore limited assistance may be provided to establish an unofficial study group. This method does NOT provide a student subject list, certificate or diploma from Global University. It also does not provide any adult continuing education transfer credit towards future programs. *It is for personal enrichment only*. No application or enrollment with Global University is required. Resources are available on disk for the study group to maintain their own records and <u>award local certificates</u>. Students will NOT have access to the online course materials or exams on http://sed.globalutraining.com.

Students who are studying for personal enrichment only may purchase course study materials by using the order form (Form E).

The Discipleship Systematic Study Plan

The Systematic Study Plan is a comprehensive approach to Bible study on the certificate and diploma level. Students will study multiple Christian topics.

Overall objectives include:

- Help students become more like Christ.
- Lead students to constantly interact with the Word of God.
- Give attention to the role of Christian service in the believer's growth.
- Provide practical lessons and monitor daily progress.

The Systematic Study Plan can be used for both the Christian Life and Christian Service courses. A certificate is awarded for the successful completion of the course work and final exam for Christian Life. A diploma is awarded for the successful completion of the course work and final exam for Christian Service (For officially enrolled students only). The following charts illustrate one way the units of study can be organized for the Christian Life and Christian Service series.
