2020 Berean & DSOM credit transfer policy

BSB transfer policy:

BSB students may receive <u>up to</u> 28 credits* of advanced standing toward an AA, Diploma, or BA degree. BSB courses must have a minimum score of 70%. Advanced standing may be applied toward required courses or electives.

*Actual amount of advanced standing depends upon the requirements of the particular program (e.g., Second BA programs allow for less transfer of credit). Transfer of credit may vary if students have also attended other accredited universities. BSB students who have completed the Ministerial Studies Diploma with Leadership Honors may receive up to 30 credits of advanced standing (additional credits for Capstone projects).

General details (based on current BSB curriculum):

- Complete level 1 (all passed, 70% or above) = up to 10 credits
- Complete level 2 (all passed, 70% or above) = up to 10 credits
- Complete level 3 (all passed, 70% or above) = up to 8 credits
- BSB Ministerial Studies Diploma (all passed, 70% or above) = up to 28 credits
- BSB Ministerial Studies Diploma with Leadership Honors (all passed, 70% or above) = up to 30 credits (additional elective credits for completion of Capstone projects).

If a student only completes some courses (no diploma or credential level completed), they may receive courses per the detailed articulation OR 1 elective credit per course (70% or above).
