- Reflect the content of this course as you consider how the subject matter under investigation relates to your own theology of ministry, and your ministry goals and objectives.
- Apply acquired knowledge and skills in a personally integrated, effective and cohesive fashion.

Your SLR will be assessed by your mentor as satisfactory or unsatisfactory. Credit and a grade for this course will be granted only after a satisfactory SLR report is submitted.
